Don't panic! You still have well over two months to do all your

shopping! However, the spirit of Christmas has already arrived in nearly 600 Bible studies across the country.

The reason for the season's early start is our new study, *God's Game Plan—Unwrapping His Perfect Gift.* It's the story of Christ's birth as told in the Gospels. We're taking off the familiar bow to discover Christ's life in a fresh way. We're unwrapping Christ's full deity and eternal life with His Heavenly Father as well as unwrapping Christ's full humanity and temporary life with His earthly parents.

One of the most exciting elements of this study is how it introduces and explains the preparation, planning, and purpose behind the birth of our Savior. God *prepared* for his birth by first speaking through the Prophets with increasing clarity and specific information. God *planned* for his birth by sovereignly placing all the people for his earlier prophecies to be fulfilled. Yet, all of God's preparation and planning would be pointless without achieving God's *purpose*. As Jesus himself told his disciples, "*The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many*" (Mark 10:45). That's why Jesus came into our world.

Now, here's the exciting part. The story of Christmas doesn't end at the stable or the cross. It doesn't even end at the resurrection. It continues on as you and I bring Jesus into our world. The various Gospel accounts of his birth carry personal relevance because, as we bring Christ into our world, we face the same reception as those we read about on the pages of Holy Scripture.

Some, like Elizabeth, Mary, Joseph, and the Magi were overjoyed at the news to the point of great sacrifice, even risking their own lives to make it possible. Others, like Herod, were outraged at the news to the point of aggression, even taking the lives of the innocent, in their feeble attempt to make it impossible. We pray that God will continue using you to unwrap His Perfect Gift and bring Christ into *your* world with the message of salvation. As you do, let me be the first to wish you a very Merry Christmas!

God's Gift in Everyday Wrapping

This fall, *The Reach* is studying events surrounding Jesus' birth. We can contrast Mary's position of favor and blessing with some heartbreaking realities. Scripture refers to the Bethlehem moment in a rather unflashy sort of way as Mary's birth pains intensified. "While they were there the time came for her to give birth. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn" (Luke 2:6-7). How anticlimactic! Yet everything went exactly as planned.

Bethlehem was synonymous with sacrificial lambs. Its hills contained thousands of lambs destined for the Temple's sin sacrifice every morning and evening. Firstborn male lambs were wrapped in swaddling cloths to

be kept "without spot or blemish" upon inspection. Luke 2:6-7 is a "sign," or, reminder of the sacrificial system, an Old Testament picture that foreshadows and points forward to Jesus.

Throughout Scripture, a scarlet thread of sacrificial blood is woven into the lives of people who experienced heartbreaking realities while doing hard things in a bigger story. And, because of the blood sacrifice, they found favor with God, pointing to Jesus and the sacrifice he made for us. "Without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins" (Hebrews 9:22).

How about you? Is your journey unfolding in an unflashy sort of way? Are you disappointed by some heartbreaking realities as you do hard things in a bigger picture?



Take heart. The Lord is weaving your story into the lives of others to foreshadow his love.

If you are a coach's wife, or know one, the invitation remains open to join *The Reach*. We filter everyday life through the pages of Scripture, enabling us to be a sign pointing to Jesus.
